Susan Gott's glass art is a synthesis of her interest in mythological imagery and symbolism, as well as philosophies from historic and ancient cultures. She says: "the archetypal images that emerge explore spirituality, existence, humor, love, magic, dualities and the beauty of life. The human form is a vessel for my connection to the Spirit." She has over 25 years of experience with the medium and specializes in cast glass to create one of a kind sculpture. Susan is the recipient of numerous grants and awards and has her work on display in major galleries, and numerous public and private collections, including the Disney Corporate Collection. Her skill in combining glass with steel and stone

furtheres the natural beauty of her pieces and connects the ancient to the contemporary.

The SoHo Arts Walk is a collaboration of more than 20 galleries, showcasing the uniqueness of the area, as well as various talented artists and takes place every third Thursday.
